Dear KMS Parent/Guardian:

Knickerbacker Middle School is identified as a School in Corrective Action for English Language Arts based upon criteria of the No Child Left Behind Act. Although the school has met the established federal and state benchmarks or Adequate Yearly Progress for total student population in math, it did not do so in the 2005-2006 and 2007-2008, 2009-2010, and 2010-2011 school years for students with disabilities and in 2010-2011 for other subgroups on the English Language Arts Assessments.

In accordance with the No Child Left Behind Act, identified schools that are able to provide a public school option must do so. For Lansingburgh, this is not the case, as there is just one middle school in the district. However, students at Knickerbacker Middle School who qualify under the federal free or reduced lunch program are eligible for tutoring through supplemental educational services (SES). If your KMS Student qualifies for free or reduced lunch and you would like to participate in free tutoring through supplemental educational services (SES), please contact Ms. Messler at 233-6811 or e-mail kmessler@lansingburgh.org to register for SES tutoring.

The Middle School also provides many other services to support student learning, such as academic intervention, summer school, after school programs, and special education services.
