

FRACTIONS, DECIMALS & PERCENTS

Overview

Teachers will be involved in using manipulatives, playing games and doing activities that focus on number sense and understanding the meaning of fractions. There will be a variety of ways for students to learn focus, and related to real-life situations. Throughout the three sessions teachers will make connections between fractions, decimals and percents and look at the development of these concepts across the grade levels.

Gail Sobolewski, Senior Math Specialist at Questar III, has taught mathematics for 31 years and has worked with students from first grade through college level. She was selected as a lead teacher for New York State in portfolio assessment and received training from the New Standards Project. Gail spent a year as the math department coordinator for Bethlehem School District, received two sabbaticals to work on math curricula and assessment for the district and has given staff development in mathematics for teachers in the district for the past fifteen years. She has given workshops at the local, state and national level for elementary and middle level teachers.
