

## SCHOOL DISTRICT GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

To further its educational philosophy, the Board of Education establishes the following goals and objectives:

1. to employ the best possible school staff, including both professional and support personnel;
2. to encourage the development of positive and supportive interpersonal relationships among the students, the staff and members of the community;
3. to maintain a sensitivity regarding the particular and individual needs of pupils and encourage the establishment of a flexible program wherein all levels of ability may be served;
4. to ensure that staff, students, and parents are afforded opportunities for meaningful participation in the development and evaluation of programs and policies;
5. to seek adequate financial support for staff, buildings, equipment and supplies;
6. to strive for maximum efficiency in the use of district resources to meet the goals and objectives of the various programs and services;
7. to provide educational programs and services which fulfill the needs of the district and comply with Commissioner's regulations;
8. to promote the development of programs and services which encourage cooperative interaction between the community-at-large and district staff and students;
9. to keep itself and the community informed of the changing educational needs in a changing world; and
10. to continually evaluate the educational program of the district.
