

GOALS FOR INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM

The district instructional program will help each student to:

1. read with comprehension;
2. think critically and reason competently;
3. communicate effectively through writing, speaking, observing, and listening;
4. develop cultural and aesthetic appreciation;
5. understand and appreciate the heritage of our democracy;
6. develop skills for vocational success;
7. act with poise, self-confidence, and good physical coordination; and
8. use mathematical skills.

Furthermore, the instructional program will assist each person to:

1. cultivate a spirit of inquiry, a desire for personal fulfillment, and a willingness to learn;
2. appreciate and respect authority and the law within a democratic process;
3. assume a fuller sense of responsibility for oneself and others;
4. achieve satisfaction in working to accomplish worthy goals;
5. develop and strengthen habits of self-discipline, a sense of responsibility, and a respect for the rights and property of others;
6. meet new conditions with resourcefulness, critical thinking, and self-assurance, knowing that changes are inevitable;
7. develop a realistic sense of self-worth and self-appraisal;
8. exhibit fair play and good sportsmanship; and
9. participate in family life and worthwhile leisure activities.

The district fully accepts the concept that learning is a lifelong process, and toward this end actively encourages people of all ages to participate in a wide range of activities.
