



Remote Learning Guidelines

During our first two weeks of remote learning, we have stressed to teachers and students that this should be considered a time for transition and adjustment to an unfamiliar mode of teaching and learning.

Now that our schools are closed until at least April 29, we have provided Chromebooks to all students so we can begin providing daily online instruction to each and every one of them. Our goal is to provide equity in opportunities and outcomes to ensure that all of our students can be successful.

Student Schoolwork Expectations

ELEMENTARY LEVEL

UPK-5 Students online learning will include review, exploration, and new instruction .

Continuity of instruction will be provided by the classroom teacher (s) through Google Classroom and Google Slides.

Instruction will be focused on standards that are the foundation for future learning in other grade levels.

Students will be provided a four-day agenda with assignments posted every Monday. The fifth day will be designed for make-up work and other District designed learning opportunities.

Students are expected to participate in **all** learning opportunities.

Special area teachers will provide new activities and resources on a weekly basis through the classroom teacher's Google Slides.

SECONDARY LEVEL

Middle School and High School Students will receive Continuity of Instruction through online learning.

Continuity of instruction will be provided through Google Classroom for each class that your child takes, including special areas.

Instruction will be focused on standards that are the foundation for future learning in other courses.

Students will be provided a four-day agenda with assignments posted every Monday. The fifth day is designed for make-up work and other District designed learning opportunities.

Students are expected to participate in **all** learning opportunities.

Special area teachers will provide new activities and resources on a weekly basis through their Google Classroom.

Student-Teacher Connections

Teachers will be available during their assigned Google Meet times. Additional appointments may be made directly with teachers.

Teachers will follow up with individual students and/or families when a student is not logging in to Google Classroom (or equivalent platform), participating in Google Meet sessions, or completing assigned work on a consistent basis.

Ongoing feedback and communication will be provided from the teacher to students, and students to teacher, to ensure student success.

Grading

The 3rd Marking Period has been extended and will close on **Friday, April 24, 2020**. The extension takes into account the weeks before formal remote learning was launched on March 30th. The 4th Marking Period will begin on **Monday, April 27th**.

Teachers will use varied forms of assessments and assignments to measure and document evidence of student learning. Students will have multiple opportunities for revision, resubmission and remedial supports.

Feedback is critical during this time to provide students with indications of meeting expectations for these assignments.

Assignments submitted may be used for grades at the teacher's discretion, as if classes were in-session.

Traditional grading practices will resume when in-person classes resume for Q4.

Special Education Services

School districts must ensure that, to the greatest extent possible, each student with a disability can be provided the special education and related services identified in the student's individualized education program (IEP). However, those services must be consistent with the need to protect the health and safety of students with disabilities and those individuals providing special education and related services to students. During this emergency, schools may not be able to provide all services in the same manner they are typically provided. Special education teachers will be providing modifications and accommodations of student assignments through their Google Meets and Google Classroom/Slides.

Academic Intervention Services

AIS providers of reading and math will plan and offer weekly review lessons, activities, and resources through Google Slides or Classroom to provide opportunities for practice of previously taught skills during RTI to both Tier 2 and Tier 3 students.

Social Emotional

All students have access to social emotional activities through Google Slides or Google Classrooms. Appointments and office hours are available for counselors, social workers, and psychologists through Google Meet.
