Dear Parents,

Thank you for your support during this time of remote learning. We realize that this time has been challenging for all of us, but we have worked together, as we always do, to support our students.

Since the 4th Marking Period was entirely online, we, as a District, have made the decision to implement an alternate grading policy for the 4th Marking Period. The following grading procedures have been made with the best interest of our students in mind.

Grading

Teachers will have used various forms of assessments and graded assignments to measure and document evidence of student learning.

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In lieu of completing the standards-based grading for MP4, teachers will complete a narrative, for each subject area, utilizing all of the instructional knowledge and academic progress data acquired throughout the 2019-2020 school-year.

4th Quarter Grades will not be a numeric entry, but will be based on the level of student engagement in remote learning. The level engagement will correspond to the following percentages:

- Highly Engaged in Remote Learning = 100%
- Moderately Engaged in Remote Learning = 85%
- Limited Engagement in Remote Learning - 65%
- No Engagement in Remote Learning - 50%

4th Quarter will be evaluated by teachers utilizing one of the following four comments:

- Highly Engaged in Remote Learning
- Moderately Engaged in Remote Learning
- Limited Engagement in Remote Learning
- No Engagement in Remote Learning

To calculate final averages, the following weighted percentages will be used:

- Quarter 1 - 35%
- Quarter 2 - 35%
- Quarter 3 - 20%
- Quarter 4 - 10%

To calculate Second Semester Courses, the following weighted percentages will be used:

- Quarter 3 - 50%
- Quarter 4 - 50%
