

With the winter athletics season upon us, the Colonial Council Conference is continuing to take precautions to prevent the transmission of COVID-19. If you plan on attending a game in person, please view the spectator guidelines of the school hosting the game. We have provided the information below.

The Albany Academies

We are excited to welcome back spectators to our indoor athletic contests this academic year. Below outlines important considerations for your health and safety, as well as the health and safety of our greater Academies community. The Albany Academies reserves the right to require more stringent COVID-19 protocols for the safety of our community. The Albany Academies are committed to promoting a safe campus environment. Failure to comply with current guidelines may result in removal from the building or facility.

All spectators must attest to the following.

- I have not tested positive nor been presumed by a medical professional to be COVID-19 positive in the last 14 days.
- I do not currently, nor have I within the last 14 days, had any of the following symptoms: fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, cough or muscle aches.
- I have not been in close contact with anyone that has tested positive or been presumed to have Covid-19 within the past 14 days.
- I have not traveled outside the United States of America within the past 14 days

All spectators must adhere to the following facilities capacity and behavior guidelines:

- Spectators will be limited to approximately 50% seating capacity as follows.
 - AAG Gym – Basketball: 150
 - AA Gym – Basketball and Wrestling: 240
 - Ice Rink - Ice Hockey: 240
 - Pool - Swimming and Diving: 120
 - Squash Courts – Squash: 24 SRO
- Only two nonfamilial spectators or up to 4 family members are allowed per participant at each contest. Spectators will always maintain a distance of at least 3 feet from others that are not in their family or pod.
- Spectators must sign in at the athletic contest for contact tracing purposes. Contact information and all group member information must be entered properly.
- Masks are required to be worn covering the nose and mouth at all times by all spectators.
- Spectators will not interact with players, coaches or game personnel during the contest.
- DO NOT bring food of any kind. Food and/or drink will not be permitted in the competition facilities (excluding water for players and coaches). Concession stands may be available.

La Salle Institute Winter Sports Capacity Policies 2021-2022

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Out of an abundance of caution and to keep our school community as safe as possible, La Salle Institute will be implementing capacity limitations to all winter sports home athletic contests effective for the 2021-2022 school year.

All spectators at all indoor home winter athletic events sponsored by La Salle Institute will be required to:

- Present a ticket in order to gain entry. Persons without an appropriate ticket will not be permitted into the event.
- Be fully masked while indoors at the event.
- Sit in close proximity (less than three feet) only with family members from their household and remain six feet apart from other spectators.
- Self-monitor prior to the contest. Spectators who display or experience any symptom of COVID-19, have a pending COVID-19 test or are a close contact to a positive COVID-19 case are not permitted entry into the event.
- Sit on the appropriate side of the gym or rink.
- For basketball - Home team spectators on the bench side of the bleachers & visitor team spectators in the bleachers across from the benches.
- For hockey – Home team spectators in the bleachers nearest the entrance & visitor team spectators in the bleachers at the far end of the rink.
- For wrestling - Home team spectators in the bleachers nearest the parking lot & visitor team spectators in the bleachers nearest the gym wall.

Spectators who are not in compliance with these regulations could be asked to leave the game site.

Tickets

Each athlete from both La Salle Institute and any opposing team will be granted two tickets each to their individual game. Tickets for La Salle athletes will be season passes. Tickets can be used only by immediate family members to the athlete. The Director of Athletics will supply the tickets to both teams prior to the date of the event. Persons not able to produce the appropriate ticket at the gate will not be permitted entry into the event. More tickets per player may be possible at home hockey games due to the size of the venue.

Basketball

Spectators permitted into the junior varsity event may stay for the varsity contest if they choose. Following any freshman game where there is a junior varsity or varsity contest right after, the gym will be cleared of spectators and those with tickets for the junior varsity game will then be admitted.

Student Admittance

Student admittance into contests for both La Salle and the visiting teams will be determined on a game by game basis. The Director of Athletics, in consultation with school administration, will make the determination.

For games that students are permitted to attend:

- A total of twenty student spectators from each school will be permitted to attend.
- La Salle students interested in attending the event will be asked to sign up in advance with the Director of Athletics and if necessary, a lottery will determine which students will attend.

Member of The Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools

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- Students from the visiting team will be given an allotment of tickets that must be presented by each individual student at the admission gate.
 - Student spectators must be fully masked and maintain appropriate social distance (3ft) from other student spectators while in the bleachers.

Lansingburgh

- Masks are required to be worn by all spectators at all times while inside the school building.
- There will be **NO Food or Drinks Allowed in the Gym** during games/contests (excluding water for players, coaches, and officials).
- A concession stand will be available in the gym lobby and all food and drink must be consumed in the gym lobby only.
- Spectators will always maintain a distance of at least 3 feet from others that are not in their family or pod.

Cohoes, Mohonasen, Schalmont & Ravena

- No spectator limits at this time
- Masks are required to be worn at all times by all spectators.
- Spectators will not interact with players, coaches or game personnel during the contest.
- Food and/or drink will not be permitted in the competition facilities (excluding water for players and coaches). Concession stands may be available, but food or drink must be consumed in the designated area.

- Masks are required to be worn by all spectators at all times while inside the school building.

- A concession stand will be available in the gym lobby/cafeteria and all food and drink must be consumed in the gym lobby/cafeteria only.
- Spectators are recommended to maintain a social distance of at least 3 feet from others that are not in their family or pod.

Spectator Guidelines for Athletic Events

- All winter sports will be offered and spectators will be permitted to attend during regular season and postseason games. ****This could change if % positive #'s continue to rise ****
- Each student athlete may have up to four spectators attend competitions at Ichabod Crane and those individuals will be seated together
- For home basketball games, seating will be organized by home, visitor and student sections.
- Face masks covering both the mouth and nose will be required for all spectators regardless of vaccination status
- There will be NO Food or Drinks Allowed in the Gym during games/contests (excluding water for players, coaches, and officials).
- A concession stand will be available in the gym lobby/cafeteria and all food and drink must be consumed in the gym lobby/cafeteria only.
