Dear Parents and Guardians,

This letter is regarding Academic Intervention Services for our students. Academic Intervention Services, or AIS, is required for all students who score below proficient (levels 1 or 2) on NYS English Language Arts and NYS Math assessments. All grade 3-8 students took the NYS English Language Arts and NYS Math assessments in April 2014.

In the past, all students who scored below proficient on the NYS English Language Arts and NYS Math assessments were provided AIS. AIS is required by the NYS Education Department. For the 2014-2015 school year Lansingburgh Central Schools will continue to provide AIS to all students who score below proficient on the NYS English Language Arts and NYS Math assessments from April 2014. The April 2014 NYS assessments were based on the new Common Core Learning Standards and used a new score range to indicate proficient. Though the test and the score range changed, Lansingburgh Central Schools will continue to provide AIS to all students who score below proficient. Remediation for students who are struggling is important.
