Policy #3230-E will go on for a first reading at the February 22 Board Meeting. The organizational chart will be modified for the Board to include names. The policy, however, will only include titles.

Policy #5152 has suggested changes to allow for district employees to enroll their children in Lansingburgh tuition-free. Mr. Cusack stated this will add toward retention of teachers. Mrs. Speanburg agreed. This policy will go on for a first reading at the February 22 Board Meeting.
