The Board reviewed Policy #0101 – Gender Neutral Single-Occupancy Bathrooms. This policy addresses Chapter 353 of the Laws of 2020, which requires school districts and BOCES boards to develop policies and procedures requiring that all single –occupancy bathrooms in public schools and BOCES be designated as gender **Policy Review**

neutral, with appropriate signage on or near the entry door. This law is effective March 23, 2021. The Board asked to have this policy put on the next agenda for a first reading.
