A. Appointments

1. Appoint Megan Hupfl - Long-Term Substitute Teacher at RPES

Recommendation:

Be it resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, that the Board of Education appoint Megan Hupfl to a Long-Term Substitute Teaching Position at Rensselaer Park Elementary School to fill the position currently held by Erika Wittman, pending clearance by New York State and the Federal Government per the Project SAVE Law, with compensation according to the LTA contract as set forth below:

V. ACTION ITEMS

A. Dusenberry Road PILOT Agreement

Recommendation:

Be it resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, that the Board of Education approve a Payment in Lieu of Taxes (PILOT) Agreement for Solar Energy Systems between Rensselaer County, Town of Brunswick and Lansingburgh Central School District and Dusenberry Lan Solar 1, LLC relating to the premises located at 60 Dusenberry Lane (Tax Map 81.-2-27.12) in the Town of Brunswick, Rensselaer County, New York; and

Be it further resolved that the Board of Education authorize the Superintendent to execute the PILOT Agreement.

B. Declare Necessity of Wall Tile Replacement at LHS

Recommendation:

WHEREAS, in June 2020, the District discovered wall tiles at Lansingburgh High School are falling from the walls, and similar conditions exist which pose similar exposure to failure.;

WHEREAS, the District's Architect has determined that the tiles in the hallways must be replaced to mitigate the safety concern;

WHEREAS, the deterioration of the tiles and substrate wall condition was an unforeseen circumstance that affects the District's property and threatens the health, safety and welfare of the students, staff and visitors of the Lansingburgh High School; and

WHEREAS, the wall tiles must be replaced immediately to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the students, staff and visitors of the Lansingburgh High School and cannot await competitive bidding;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the District as follows:

1. The Board of Education hereby determines and declares that the above described occurrence and the condition thereby created constitutes an immediate public emergency within the meaning of General Municipal Law Section 103(4) arising out of an accident or other unforeseen occurrence or condition whereby circumstances affecting public buildings, public property or the life, health, safety or property of the students, staff and visitors of the Lansingburgh High School and other persons did and does require immediate remedial corrective action that cannot await public competitive bidding; and
2. Contracts for public work or the purchase of supplies, materials or equipment necessary to repair the wall tiles may be let by the Superintendent of the district, or her designee, without competitive bidding and by whatever means necessary to complete the work in the most practical manner in accord with applicable law and the best interests of the district; and
3. The Superintendent of the District, or her designee, be and is hereby authorized to negotiate and let the contract for repair of wall tile work in an amount not to exceed \$100,000; and

This Resolution shall take effect immediately and shall also ratify previous actions undertaken by the District staff to implement the repair work and to preserve safety under the circumstances.

C. Approve Expenditure of Repair Reserve Funds for Tile at LHS

Recommendation:

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Lansingburgh Central School District previously established a repair reserve fund pursuant to New York General Municipal Law section 6-d; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Lansingburgh Central School District intends to expend money from such reserve fund for the purposes of replacement of wall tile in the Lansingburgh High School, including contingencies; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the provisions of section 6-d of the General Municipal Law, the Board of Education has declared this an emergency project for the health and safety of staff and students with a proposed appropriation of a sum not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the previously established repair reserve fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the expenditure of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the previously established repair reserve fund for the purposes of tile replacement, including contingencies.

D. Approval of Change Order for Lansingburgh High School Renovation Project

Recommendation:

Be it resolved, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, that the Board of Education accept and approve Change Order #GC-001 relating to the renovation project at Lansingburgh High School.
