OVERVIEW

Remote learning training will be scheduled for families on Thursday, September 10 from 6pm-6:30pm.

Instructional Overview

- Students will receive a full schedule of courses as required by the New York State Education Department for their grade level
- Students are expected to follow their daily schedule
- Classes will be held online 5 days a week following A, B, C, D block schedule
- Instruction will be delivered using Google Classroom as our primary learning management system
- Teachers will deliver synchronous learning opportunities through Google Meet
- Students will have opportunities to interact with teachers and other students in a number of ways, including but not limited to the following:
 - Emails using the district issued e-mail addresses
 - Feedback will be provided through Google Classroom assignments
 - Google Meet for groups and meetings with individual students
- **Please note - if/when we return to hybrid learning, those students who choose to continue learning remotely may have schedules adjusted due to teacher availability. This may include adjustments in elective class availability.

Grading/Assessments

- Students will receive an overall grade that is a percentage out of 100, aligned with teacher-specific grading policies. See individual teacher syllabi/course expectations.
- Grades will be available via the Parent Portal in Schoology.

Communication

- Teachers will be available by email, and/or Google Meet by appointment, to ensure ongoing communication between teachers and families
- Teachers will have assigned office hours until 2:35pm each day

Attendance

- Attendance in every Google Meet during your class period is required
- Attendance will be taken during each Google Meet, and submitted through our students management system, SchoolTool
- Attendance will be available for families to view through the Parent Portal
- The District's attendance policies will remain in effect, whether remote or in-person

Remote Learning Instruction

Students and Teachers will follow assigned schedules during remote instruction.

CORE Classes

Core Classes will be run remotely using the following schedule:

- Take Attendance

- Student Work Time: Breakout Groups, Independent Work, etc.
- Regroup at the end of block to receive feedback, review work submitted
- Teacher remains available via original meet link during this time
